

# Tweed Netball Association Inc Nicole Cusack Club Carnival 2023

## **Information Booklet**

Welcome to TNA's Nicole Cusack Club Carnival 2023. TNA is excited to hold this carnival after a 3year break. We wish you all a fantastic day of netball. The following information will ensure the smooth running of the carnival and an enjoyable day for all.

#### Check In

All Team delegates must check in at the TNA clubhouse / office at the beginning of the carnival in case there are any changes to the day.

#### Draw

The draw will be available on the TNA website / facebook & Netball Connect by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> August 1230pm. It will be also displayed at the clubhouse on the day of carnival.

## Games Commence

First round starts at 8.00am sharp

## Game Times

All games will consist of two twelve (12) minute halves with a two (2) minute break at half time, and four (4) minutes between games. All games will be centrally controlled.

#### Injury

No injury time or extra time will be added for blood rule.

#### Uniforms

All players must be in matching uniforms with positional patches.

#### Umpiring

Each team must supply a capable umpire suitably attired to umpire their team. TNA will not supply umpires on the day.

#### Players

Players DO NOT need to sign a score sheet.

#### Live Scoring

Will be done via Netball Connect. Scorers (1 from each team) are required to sit / stand together on side line as indicated on map in following pages.

#### Balls

Teams are required to supply their own ball(s) for games

## **Points**

Two (2) points will be awarded for a win and One (1) points for a draw and Zero (0) point for a loss. If a team wins by forfeit they will receive Two (2) points. There will be 0 points for a Bye. This competition will be run as first and second place on ladder. . In the event that 2 or more teams are tied for either position, then goal percentages will be used to determine 1st and 2nd placings, i.e. Goals For/Goals/Against. If teams are still tied on percentage, then the result of the game between those teams will be used, if that was a draw, then total goals scored, and finally then goal difference to determine placings. A progressive ladder will be available via Netball Connect.

## Presentations

Awards will be presented to the winners and runners up of each division. (9 per team) Presentation will take place at the end of the last round. All winners and runners up are to assemble on courts 8 & 9 in front of clubhouse promptly following the conclusion of last round.

## **First Aid**

A First Aid officer will be on site between toilets & clubhouse office. If an ambulance is required, the First Aid officer or TNA delegate will make this call.

## Tents / Gazebo's

Please refer to the attached map for areas strictly allocated for tents / gazebo's Tents must be securely fastened to the ground for the safety of all.

#### Food & Beverage

Plenty of food and beverages options available, BBQ and Canteen at the Clubhouse. Coffee Cart and Slushie/Fairy Floss van also available.

#### **Ban on Cooking**

Team / Spectator BBQs or cooking of any kind is NOT permitted at our courts.

## Alcohol / Smoking / Vaping

Is NOT permitted at our courts



EFTPOS will be available at all vendors, our canteen and BBQ. No ATM on site. The closest ATM can be found at Coles Express Cnr Heffron St & Mindgunbal Drive approx. 500metres.

#### **Bubblers**

Located between Court 8 and the clubhouse.







## Dogs

TNA and Tweed Shire council request that dogs are not at the courts during game / carnival days.



## Toilets

Toilets (4x female, 4 x male and 1x Disabled access) are located at clubhouse. Port a Loos will be also be available as marked on map. Clubhouse toilet is only available for TNA Executive & designated Officials.

## Rubbish

Rubbish bins are situated around the grounds. Please ensure you keep your area and our grounds tidy at all times. Earn & Return (can's / bottles redemption program) Yellow bins will also be available.

## Reminder

No chairs, umbrellas, skateboards or scooters between courts.

## Parking

Plenty of parking available for cars and buses. Be mindful of parking legally in surrounding streets, and also be thoughtful of our residential neighbours – do not park across driveways. Council regularly patrol the area especially during game days. Please do NOT park in the emergency access bays as marked on map. TNA Executive reserves the right to hold carparks for TNA executive / delegates.

## Behaviour

TNA has zero tolerance to abusive language and / or inappropriate, unsportsmanlike behaviour on or off the court. All players, teams and spectators must adhere to Netball QLD and TNA's Code of Conduct.

## **Rolling Substitutions**

Rolling substitutions can be used during the Nicole Cusack Club Carnival. Players waiting to take the court must do so from the left of Transverse line and must ensure they do not go offside when entering the court and, must make sure they do not interfere with the umpire's view of the game. (see diagram on following page)


Teams will be allowed to make substitutions during play – this includes during stoppages and intervals. There is no limit to the number of substitutions that can be made and more than one substitution may be made at any time. Play will not be held up for substitutions.


The incoming player must wait until the player being replaced exits the court before entering the field of play.
